Warren Members Competed in Major Asia-Pacific Competitions in Dubai and Abu Dhabi

Warren Members; Justin Kuk and Aloysa Atienza recently competed in the Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship ("AAC") and the Women's Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship ("WAAP") respectively, two of the most prestigious tournaments in the amateur golfing world, which gave both of them wonderful opportunities to pit their skills against some of the best players in the amateur world.

After a hiatus last year due to Covid-19 pandemic, the men's competitions at the AAC was held this year between the 3rd - 6th November 2021, respectively at the famous championship course at Dubai Creek Golf & Yacht Club in Dubai, UAE (originally designed by Karl Litten and subsequently redesigned by Thomas Bjorn). The ultimate prize for winning the AAC is to receive an invitation to play in the Masters Tournament and the British Open, the following year and past winners include 2-time champion and current Masters champion, Hideki Matsuyama.

Warren Junior and SGA National Squad Member, Justin Kuk was part of a 4-man Singapore team, which was sent to this year's AAC. Selection is based on WAGR ranking at time of selection. After 4 days of tough intense competition, Justin closed the week at AAC with a cumulative score of 284 (72, 70, 72, 70) which placed him in joint T33rd position in the field. In reflection on his week competing in Dubai, Justin had this to say:

"As this is my first overseas competition in 2 years, my first time playing AAC, and first time playing in this region, I actually did not know what to expect from my game this week. I have been playing reasonably well in Singapore, and was happy to translate some of that form to this week at AAC, by scoring 18 birdies this week. The biggest challenge for me this week was walking 6 days (including practice rounds) in a row in desert temperatures. I learnt this week that I still have a lot more to improve to be where I want to be, and I know now the level of play that I need to have in order to compete with the best.

My best memories from this week are being in a new country with my teammates, experiencing new different conditions, and competing as part of a team. I just want to say thank you to the organisers of AAC, for their superb organisation and hospitality which anticipated all our needs, to SGA and Sentosa GC for sending and giving us the opportunity to train for this competition, and my coach Matt Ballard and my teammates for their support. "

This year's WAAP was held at the Abu Dhabi Golf Club between 10th - 13th November 2021. Warren Member and SGA Development Squad Player, Aloysa Atienza, was one of the 7 Singapore players selected to participate in this year's WAAP. The Abu Dhabi Golf Club is a championship venue that provides a tough but fair challenge and has hosted multiple European Tour events. The winner of WAAP will get to play in 2 major championships i.e. The AlG Women's Open and the Amundi Evian Championship, as well as other tournaments.





Aloysa started her competition with a bang carding birdies on her 1st 9 holes and was in fact at one stage on top of the leaderboard. She closed the 1st day with 5 birdies and a 1 over score. On the 2nd day, Aloysa struggled to maintain her momentum but kept on fighting all the way. Unfortunately, she closed her 2-day score with a cumulative +3, and just missed the halfway cut which was at +2.

Reflecting on her week at Abu Dhabi, Aloysa shared:

"As this is my first major overseas tournament, I just wanted to play my best and see how far up the leaderboard I could get. I prepared as well as I could especially on my short game with coach Matt at Sentosa GC, and also did a lot of mental preparation with sports psychologist Hansen Bay to make sure that I could take the pressure. Although I missed the cut by a single stroke, my experience playing the WAAP has shown me that I have the golf skills to compete and am capable of playing in an elite field to contend.

My best memory of this week is the fact that I was the early leader of the event after 8 holes. The next step for me is to hold that lead for another 64 holes to win the championship."

Warren Ladies Top 4th National Ranking Game and HSBC YGC 1st Leg

Warren ladies and girls dominated at the recently concluded 4th National Ranking Game (NRG) cum HSBC Youth Golf Challenge 1st Leg (HSBC), which was played on the Aranda/ Vanda courses at Orchid Country Club between 14th to 16th December 2021.

In the Ladies division of the NRG, Warren Member, Aloysa Atienza was tied at level par after the first 2 rounds of competition, with Seletar's Hailey Loh and Yu Shang. One flight ahead, Warren Junior, Xingtong Chen, was only one shot back at +1 going into the final day.

On the first 9 of final round, Seletar's Hailey Loh showed her determination to take an early lead by recording 3 birdies and led by 1 shot as she finished her 1st 9 holes at -1. Meanwhile, Aloysa made the turn at even par by registering a solitary birdie to offset a bogey, while Yu Shang had fallen off the pace by making the turn at +3.

However, Aloysa put pedal to the metal in the 2nd 9 holes, by quickly birdieing holes 10 and 11 to tie the match, and then recording another 2 birdies to close out the match and win this NRG on countback (74, 70, 69). Xingtong Chen took 3rd placing for this NRG by recording 3-day score of +6 (72, 73, 77).

Meanwhile in the Girls B division of HSBC (for girls 12 - 14 years of age), Warren's Xingtong Chen, Tatiana Ang, Sydnie Ng and Asara Sawhney participated. Xingtong Chen took the Girls B division title winning by 5 shots over another talented Warren Junior, Tatiana Ang, who shot a cumulative +11 (77, 71, 79), and was placed 7th for the NRG. Sydnie Ng finished in 11th position with a cumulative score of +41 (87, 82, 88). Xingtong and Tatiana look to continue Warren's dominance in Girls B division, taking over the mantle from 4-time winner, Warren Junior Jillian Kuk, who has since graduated to Girls A division.

Other notable results by Warren ladies / juniors in this NRG:

- Jillian Kuk 8th position with cumulative score of +16 (232)
- Kimiko Ang 11th position with cumulative score of +22 (238)
- Passion Hsu 12th position with cumulative score of +29 (245)


