# MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

My dear fellow Warren members

I am glad to have this opportunity to “speak” to you so soon after the virtual Annual General Meeting.

Thank you for giving me the mandate to serve as the President of the Club.

I know there are challenges that we as a Club have to confront and overcome. I know there are issues that you want to see actions on. I know you have many ideas and feedback on how we can do better as a Management Committee (MC), as a Club Management and as a Club.

That is why the MC wasted no time in getting to work very quickly.

First, whilst it is not the tradition of the Club President to write a letter to all incoming MC members, I deemed it fit to establish the standards and expectations for ourselves right at the start of our term:

(A) Integrity

- Do the right things at all times with the interest of the Club coming first above all else. No Warren, nothing else matters.

(B) Servant Leadership

- We are in the MC to serve members and enhance the standing of the Club. To serve requires the MC members to put others before self.

(C) Personal Conduct

- Be humble, gracious and magnanimous. Don't “sia sway” (embarrass) ourselves and the MC.

(D) Right vs Popular

- Resist the temptation to take the popular option. Always act right and in the interest of the Club though a tinge of realism is needed at times.

(E) Conflict of Interest

Second, we expeditiously established five key areas for the MC to focus upon. These are areas we know are important to you. We gathered these from our daily interactions with you, from the many questions and clarifications you raised during the run up to our recent AGM and the aftermath of it.

## FOCUS AREAS OF MC 2021-2023:

- Land Lease
- An appropriate Golf Booking System for Warren
- Strengthen Financial Position
- Bring Vibrancy to the Club
- Engagement with Members

(A) Accelerate the talk on our lease extension (President)  
- To intensify and accelerate engagement with SLA on this matter.

- Also to start making preparation for any eventuality.

(B) A suitable and appropriate booking system for us (Captain)

- We will deep dive to understand the booking system used by all the other golf clubs in Singapore. We want to understand the pros and cons of each with the goal of determining one that is most suitable and appropriate for Warren.

(C) Strengthening our financial position (Wendy Chia and Agnes Chan)

- What can we do to increase revenue and manage our cost more effectively?

(D) Let's bring the vibrancy back to Warren! (Catherine Kwek and Katie Tan)

- What can we do to restore the buzz, the vibes and the ebullience to the Club?

(E) Let's enhance our MC members' engagement with all of you (Catherine and Katie)

- What can we do to have more and frequent opportunities to listen to your voices? It will also be an opportunity for MC members to explain our rationale when we have differing views.

I have enlisted the help of some MC members (names listed in parentheses above) to champion each of these focus areas. They will be brainstorming ideas and they may approach you for your views too.

I urge all of you to participate actively and offer your views so that all our eventual action plans for each of the five areas will be “BY YOU, FOR YOU AND WITH YOU”.

As these areas will need careful planning and detailed discussion, I hope you will be patient with us. Nevertheless, whenever we are ready with any, we will share them with you.

Well, like they say “At the end of the day, let the talking stop and the actions show”.

On this cue, I will end my maiden message and will provide more updates as we move forward.

# Warren Juniors among Podium Finishers at National School Games 2021

In the recently held National School Games (NSG), Warren Junior and Singapore Sports School (SSP) student athlete Inez Ng took Gold in the Girls A Division and in the Girls B Division, Warren Juniors Tatiana Ang (MGS), Jillian Kuk (MGS) and Sarah Lim (NGHS) dominated the podium by taking 2nd, 3rd and 4th placings respectively.

After a hiatus of a year last year due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the NSG for golf resumed this year on 20 April 2021 at Laguna National Golf and Country Club's Masters course. This year's tournament was shortened to a one-day event and was limited to an individual competition. Due to social distancing concerns, players from the same schools were also grouped in the same flights for this competition, which added another level of difficulty as the players had no idea how well their competitors were doing during their matches (given there were no leaderboards).

In the Girls A Division, despite a shaky start on her first hole (hole 10), Inez stabilised her game and recovered with a 1 under score on her back 9, which allowed her to card a 2 over overall score of 74. This enabled her to pull away by 8 strokes from her nearest competitor from CJC and romp away from the rest of the limited field.

In the Girls B Division, the competition was much more intense as the girls from Nanyang, MGS and SSP battled it out for the title. After their 1st nine holes (which was played over the Masters course back 9), Warren Junior Tatiana Ang (MGS), was in the lead by making the turn at 1 over, followed closely by Angel Lim (NGHS) and Jaymie Ng (SSP) at 2 over. On the back 9, eventual winner Angel Lim came back strongly with a 1 under score (to finish with a 1 over score of 73 for the entire round), followed by Warren Junior Jillian Kuk (MGS) who recovered strongly from a train wreck first 9, with an even par back 9.

Results of our Warren podium finishers in Girls B Division are as follows:

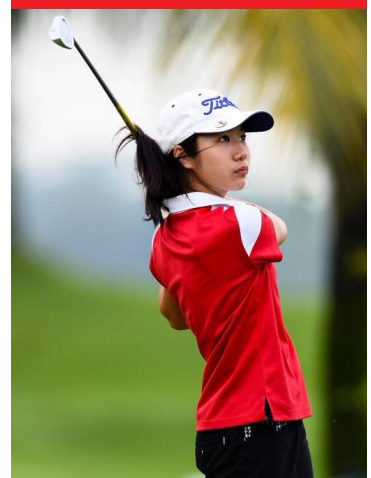

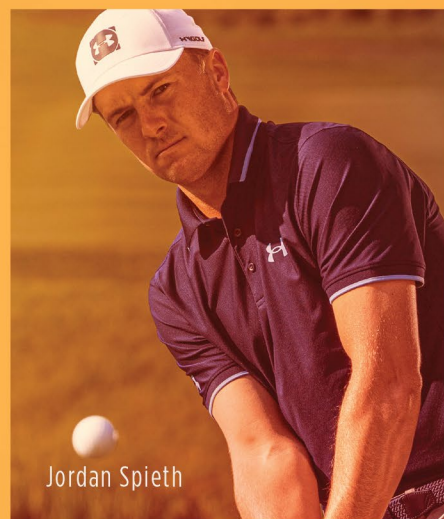

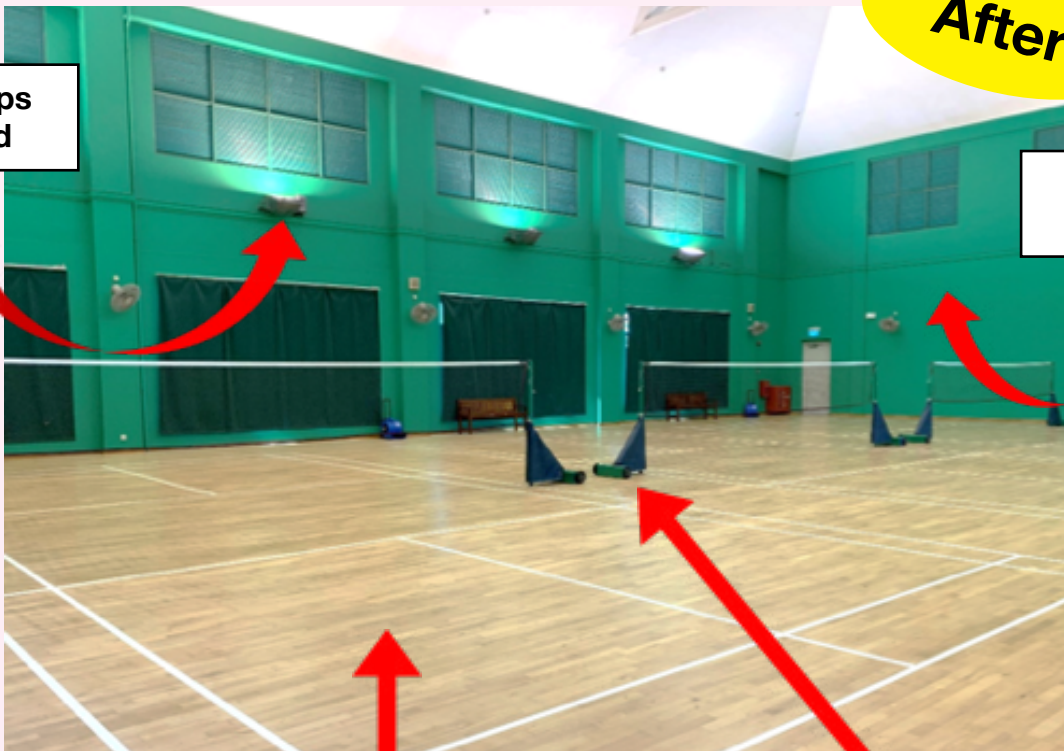
