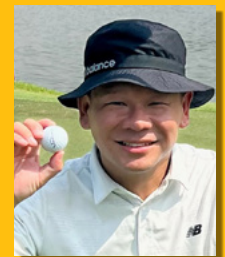

Do you know as a Golfer?

1. Golfers are NOT allowed to drive the buggy beyond the restricted area at the fairway that is cordoned off by course maintenance team. This is due to recovery programs of the turf.
2. Golfers are advised to return their buggies immediately upon finishing their golf game. Failing to do so, golfers will be charged with \$27.00nett per pax.
3. Under Club Rules 5.3(g), all morning flights must complete the first nine holes and turn around by 11.45am, failing which continuation of the second nine holes shall be disallowed (inclusive of suspension of play due to inclement weather). Tee off times after 11.45am shall be reserved for flights in the afternoon session.

“Ask Our Trainer”

“I want to start a fat loss phase, but I don’t know where to begin. Any advice?”

The cornerstone to any weight loss journey is setting your daily calorie intake. Begin by setting a weight goal. Multiply this by 26.4 and voila - your daily calorie allowance is set!

Example:

If you aim to be 72kg, Your daily calorie allowance should be: $72 \times 26.4 = 1900$ calories.

However, not to be a slave to precision, as I advocate for calorie ranges rather than a fixed number. This way, you will have some flexibility. For instance, aim for 1800 - 2000 calories per day, this approach is not only more sustainable but it is also realistic.

For your daily protein consumption, multiply your weight goal by 1.54 to find your recommended protein intake.

Example:

For a weight goal of 72kg, your daily protein consumption will be $72 \times 1.54 = 111\text{g}$.

Similar to calorie intake, don't fret if you exceed this number; but remember this is your daily minimum protein requirement.

Next will be your daily fiber consumption. For women, you should consume at least 25g of fiber daily. As for men, aim for 35g. These are the minimums; however I encourage you to exceed them. A daily fiber intake of 40-50g from whole foods would be fantastic.

Besides what you consume, set a goal for daily steps of at least 7500, but feel free to go beyond. Anything above 10000 daily steps is commendable. If you are not there yet, don't worry you can gradually work towards to it.

Strength training is also a crucial part of this equation. I recommend training 2, 3, or 4 times a week. Here are some examples of strength training frequency:

2x: Full Body/ Full Body

3x: Lower Body/ Upper Body/ Full Body

4x: Lower/ Upper/ Lower/Upper

Remember, factors like sleep, stress, and hydration also play vital roles in your fat loss journey. They influence the pace and sustainability of your weight loss. But rest assured, consistently following the guidelines outlined in this article will lead you to fat loss. You can consider this as my personal guarantee.

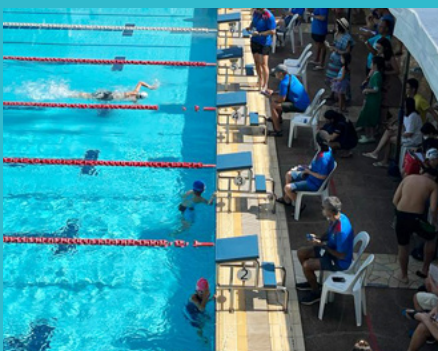

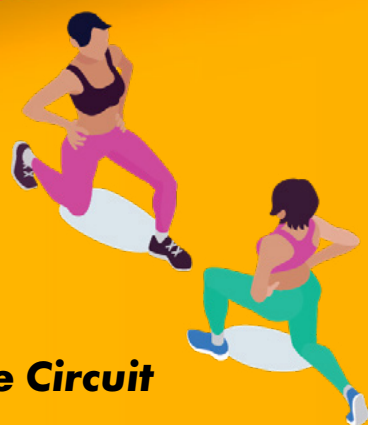
