# BRING YOUR OWN CONTAINER – "Choose Reusables not Disposables"

Disposables are items designed for single use before they are thrown away. In 2020, about 200,000 tonnes of domestic waste disposed of in Singapore were disposables. This comprised of both packaging and non-packaging items such as carrier bags, food and beverage containers, tablewares and utensils. The amount of waste disposed is equivalent to 400 Olympic-size swimming pools. At the rate that we currently create waste, our only landfill, Semakau Landfill, will be fully filled by 2035!

#### **HOW CAN WE DO OUR PART?**

As part of this commitment, we are also transitioning from the use of conventional plastic to higher cost biodegradable takeaway containers designed to naturally break down, minimising environmental impact. In addition, Golfers' Terrace will also stop giving plastic straws from 01 January 2024.

With effect from 01 January 2024, for members who bring their own containers for takeaway at Golfers' Terrace, we will extend a \$0.50 discount on the total bill as a token of appreciation for supporting our 'Go Green' initiative. However, please note that an extra charge of \$0.30 per beverage and \$0.50 per food item will apply for takeaway packaging.




