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# MESSAGE FROM CAPTAIN

Dear fellow members,

As this would be my final swan song as your Captain, I do hope that during my four year tenure, my Golf Sub-Committee and I have managed to elevate your golfing experiences at Warren.

Truth be told - there were many issues before, during and after the Covid debacle that had to be tackled. I must compliment and thank members of my Golf Sub-Committee and the golfing team at Warren for their dedication and commitment in facing these challenges.

Feedback from members on the multitude of issues raised was discussed and deliberated for a measured and hopefully acceptable conclusion to members' satisfaction. Arriving at a decision requires not only subordinating to members' feedback but they had to be macro-viewed from the financial, physical and logistical aspects and conditions of the Club and golf course.

I am proud and honoured to be entrusted with the responsibilities of overseeing not only golfing issues at Warren but also issues arising out of our 24-year-old course. I am fortunate to have a great team of Sub-Committee members. My Vice-Captain and his Sub-Committee members collectively oversee the Driving Range, Handicapping & Junior Development. My Greens Convenor and his Sub-Committee members, together with the Golf Course Superintendent and his whole Golf Course Maintenance team, look after our challenging and much talked about golf course. And not forgetting my Lady Captain & Lady Vice-Captain and their Sub-Committee members who oversee one of the strongest makeup of lady memberships we have to date.

There were many deliberations and decisions that have been taken to improve the golfing ecosystem at Warren and I must admit that there are instances whereby things could have been better managed. I make no apologies for the decisions undertaken as I believe that we have rationalised and deliberated at length to arrive at the conclusions for the betterment of the majority of the membership. I have often encouraged members to provide feedback and raise issues to see to the improvement to golfing for the good of the Club and its members, and will continue to do so.

Policies and decisions of authoritarian natures will inevitably incur the wrath of some members – but would still have to be instituted to bring civility and enjoyment for all. From no smoking on the golf course, proper dress codes, adhering to the pace of play, to the repairing of divots, ball marks and raking of bunkers are all marque of a true “gentleman” golfer. Rules and regulations of play are implemented so that everyone will have an enjoyable golfing experience and at the same time, they help maintain the pristine condition and integrity of our aged golf course.

Frustrations and tempers may flare up during the game for all kinds of reasons and I urge members to restrain and calm themselves - as golf can be a fatal sport when anger gets in the way of better judgement. The Club's Disciplinary Sub-Committee takes a very serious view on dangerous play and bad behaviours on the golf course. Patience and tolerance should be the order of the day. After all, you would have to invest a good four to five hours of your time playing that round of 18 holes, so why rush and get yourselves agitated and upset?

I do note that members are anxious and worried about our Club's lease extension beyond 2030. The Club President and Management Committee have opened communications with the Singapore Land Authority on this urgent issue and we are still awaiting a favourable response from them. But until then, let's all go out and enjoy the camaraderie that the game provides and the “Game of a Lifetime” that golf offers.

## Do you know as a Golfer?

1. Golfers are reminded to ensure that players in front are out of range before taking each shot to avoid any potential dangerous play.
2. Any golf flight cancellations must be made by every Friday (before 10am) before the playing week. Late cancellation shall be subject to a penalty fee of \$43.60nett per ball.

### 3. Pace of Play (POP)

In recent months, the Club has noticed an escalation of dangerous play and bad behaviours on the golf course. The most common excuse received from the Complainants is that they are keeping to the POP as indicated on the POP Chart. **Please note that the POP Chart is used as a guidance on the play time of your round of golf. The general rule of thumb is that golfers have to also keep up with the flight in front of them.**

Misunderstandings could and can result in dangerous play and bad incidences on the golf course. The Disciplinary Sub-Committee takes a very serious view on dangerous play and bad behaviours on the golf course. So be patient and keep your cool to enjoy your round of golf. Thank you for your cooperation.

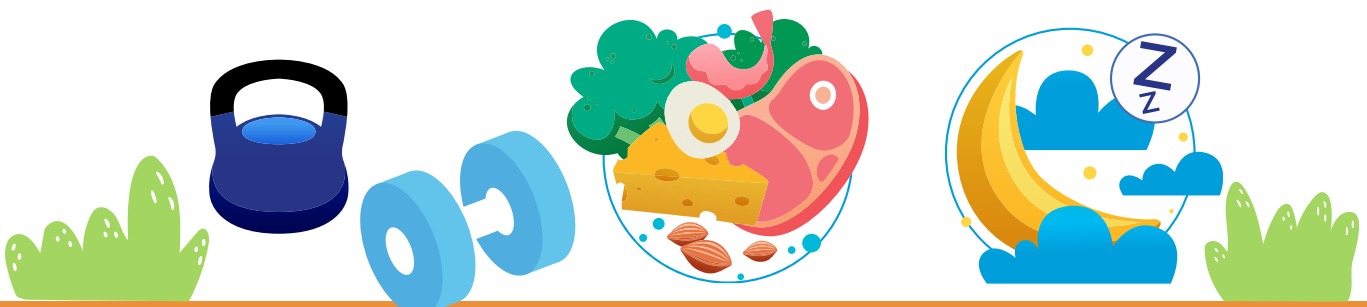

# WARREN 6-RED SNOOKER CHAMPIONSHIP

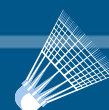
