Dear fellow members

This will prevent further range balls from leaving the Driving Range, ensuring a safer environment for all golfers on the course.

A Tribute to Uncle Sam

It is with great sadness that we bid farewell to our beloved coaching professional, Shamuri Sedek, who passed away on 20 October 2024.

Affectionately known as "Uncle Sam," Shamuri Sedek was a familiar and cherished figure among Warren golfers.

Uncle Sam began his journey with Warren Golf & Country Club (then known as Warren Golf Club) at just 23 years old in November 1974, managing the Pro Shop and teaching golf at the old club location on Folkestone Road. In 1977, he took over the running of the Pro Shop, a role he held until 1999 when the Club moved to its current location in Choa Chu Kang. Even after stepping down from managing the shop, he remained a dedicated Golf Professional with the Club.

His passion and commitment to coaching golf remained steadfast throughout his long and distinguished career. Uncle Sam devoted himself to teaching golfers of all ages, from children just picking up their first clubs to seasoned adults looking to refine their skills. His dedication went beyond the formal lessons - he would often offer helpful tips and advice to golfers at the range and practice green, even when it wasn't required of him. Whether working with beginners or advanced players, Uncle Sam's golfing knowledge left a lasting impact on everyone he encountered. His willingness to share his expertise, purely out of his love for the game and desire to help others improve, is a testament to the deep passion that defined his career.

Rest in peace, Uncle Sam. You will be dearly missed by all at Warren.

SOLAR ENERGY FOR THE CLUB

Towards the end of last year, we embarked on a decision to transition to a cleaner energy source with the installation of photovoltaic (solar) panels on our roof spaces.

After a tumultuous journey, marked by challenges from the steep pitched roofs, inclement weather, and various project management issues, the project has finally been completed.

Solar panels are now in place on the roofs of the Main Clubhouse, Sports Complex, Driving Range, and Golf Course Maintenance Complex.

A total of 1,034 pieces of solar panels have been installed, capable of generating a total of 599.72 kWp of energy, which accounts for about 20% of the Club's electricity needs.

Following the successful connection of the solar panel cables to our electrical system over two nights, on 10 and 26 September 2024, we began harnessing solar energy on 27 September 2024.

We thank you for your patience and understanding during the installation period.

Driving Range Safety Nettings








Embarking on Your Strength Training Journey: A Beginner's Guide

Remember, strength training should be enjoyable and challenging while enhancing your quality of life.

Key Takeaways for Success

- 1. Focus on mastering basic movements before adding complexity
- 2. Consistency is key. Stick to your chosen workout schedule
- 3. Gradually increase weights as you become stronger
- 4. Listen to your body and adjust as needed
- 5. Do not chase soreness. Instead, aim for steady progress
