

# Reciprocal Arrangement with SEREMBAN INTERNATIONAL GOLF CLUB

For Warren Golf & Country Club Members visiting this club:

Members of each club may use the facilities of the other participating club (“Host Club”) subject to:

1. The extent of their own membership privileges at their “Home Club” (including signing in of guest; green fees at prevailing rates);
2. The rules, by-laws and operational practices of the Host Club;
3. The availability of facilities at time of visit; and
4. All the conditions stated in the following clauses:
  - a. The period of reciprocity in respect of each member will be limited to a maximum of fourteen (14) times in any one calendar year and maximum of three (3) times in any calendar month.
  - b. Members of each Club will not be permitted to sign for any expenses incurred at the Host Club, including the pro-shops, the F&B facilities and any other paying facilities. Where cash or credit cards are accepted, payment will be in cash or credit card, and where only coupons are accepted then payments would be made by coupons purchased at the respective club.
  - c. The relevant usage fees payable by members of the Host Club will also be payable by guest members.
  - d. Reciprocal Members to present a valid reciprocal card or an official letter of introduction with their valid membership card from their Home Club duly signed by the Club General Manager or Captain to be eligible for reciprocal privileges.
  - e. The reciprocal arrangement is not open to members of either Clubs on Absent Membership.
  - f. Reciprocal Members wishing to play golf may make reservation for tee off time on weekdays, weekends and public holidays, subject to availability and the restriction of the Host Club.
  - g. Reciprocal Members are to abide by all rules and regulations of the Host Club. The Host Club reserves all rights to take the appropriate actions for Reciprocal Members who have breached Club rules and regulations.
  - h. The Host and Home Clubs would not be held responsible for the actions of the Guest Member.
  - i. The reciprocity does not extend to residents in and citizens of the visiting countries.
